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The goals of the Chrysalis Charter School Community are to provide a unique and nourishing learning environment where children:

- Learn subjects with the intent to understand, rather than only memorize,
- Are placed in classes appropriate for their academic level.
- Have opportunities to pursue their own interests and hone their intellectual, social, and personal skills,
- Treat each other and their teachers with respect and kindness, and
- Experience significant immersion in nature.

In order to achieve our mission, your family is expected to actively participate in the Chrysalis community by contributing 40 hours of service to the school each year and make the following contractual promises (described in greater detail in the Parent-Student Handbook).

Your student(s), \_\_\_\_\_, \_\_\_\_\_, \_\_\_\_\_ will:

- Comply with rules and behavioral expectations.
- Complete at least 90% of class assignments, turning them in on time.
- Arrive to school on time,
- Maintain at least 95% attendance (unless there are extenuating circumstances).
- Care for and return, in good condition, all Chrysalis books and materials checked out.

Parental obligations to the Chrysalis community will include:

- Paying bills (for school lunches, afterschool care, damaged materials, returned checks) in a timely manner.
- Following the Parent Code of Ethics and other guidelines described in the Parent-Student Handbook while on campus or at a Chrysalis event.
- Following the conflict resolution procedures described in the Parent-Student Handbook in the case you have a conflict with some aspect of the school.

In the event that either you or your student are not meeting your requirements, Chrysalis administration and teachers will give verbal and/or written feedback to this effect. If the situation does not resolve, we will ask you to meet with the Chrysalis Board so both parties can find a resolution. If, at the end of the year, the Chrysalis Board determines that your family did not fulfill your part of the contract, the Board can choose not to renew this learning contract for the following year. If there is a breach of contract threatening the safety or educational integrity of the school community at any time, the Board may cancel this contract before the end of the school year.
